MiFID II Information

On 3 January 2018, The Markets in Financial Instruments Directive II (MiFID II) became effective.

To assist intermediaries and clients, here is a summary of some key MiFid II information:

T. Bailey Asset Management (TBAM) is a MiFID regulated entity.

TBAM acts as Investment Manager to two FCA-Authorised UCITS Funds – T. Bailey Dynamic Fund and T. Bailey Growth Fund. The Authorised Fund Manager of these funds is T. Bailey Fund Services Limited (TBFS). TBFS is a UCITS firm not a MiFID firm.

The European MiFID Template (EMT)
